

# Choices Explorer Research Document

## Home Tab

1. Look over page (can get to everything from here)
2. Look at this weeks “highlights” & “trivia”

**Learn Tab** (Plan your high school courses, or start by exploring majors for after high school. You can also take the Major Finder Quiz.)

1. Start with “Major Finder Quiz”
2. Fill in interests on quiz
3. Print results
4. Click on and read at least 5 majors (read “profile” & “talking to students”)
5. Interesting career or major? –put it in portfolio (use link)
6. Now try choosing a major from “choose a major zone” – again click on and read at least 5 majors – (interesting finds? - put in portfolio link)
7. Finally find majors by “your school subjects” – again click on and read at least 5 majors – (interesting finds? - put in portfolio link)
8. You must have at least 5 majors saved to your portfolio
9. Read 2 blogs from college students

## Work Tab

1. Just for fun – click on the “leave your life to chance” link – try the “Career-O-Matic”
2. Do the “Career Finder”
3. Print your interests & your skills
4. Look at careers (change to 100 results) – (Be sure to read: What they do, Salary & outlook, Education, Interview, Get started)
5. Click on “More” about at least 5 careers that interest you (interesting finds? - put in portfolio link)
6. Go to “Choose a Career Zone” and find at least 5 careers that you are interested in (interesting finds? - put in portfolio link)
7. Go to “Your School Subjects” section and find at least 5 careers that you are interested in (interesting finds? - put in portfolio link)
8. You must have at least 5 careers saved to your portfolio
9. Read at least 2 work blogs

## Your Portfolio

1. Look at portfolio
2. Be sure to have saved majors and saved careers (each day everything is cleared except those on the left - that you have saved)
3. Choose your most desirable/most interesting career – click on the saved link and take notes – (from What they do, Salary & outlook, Education, Interview, Get started) – Save your journal entry
