Band- This is for the 6th graders coming into band, for the 7th and 8th grade students currently in the program or wishing to begin in band, for students going into 9th grade and for high school students who want to sit in and play. This is a great way to keep your fingers and lips in shape. This is a great way to meet new friends and get acquainted with the band program. We will play all types of exciting music. Band will be good for improving your sight-reading skills. Band will meet every morning Monday-Friday 10:00 a.m.-11:00 a.m. in the band room at LaSalle. **Cost= \$35.00**

Individual Lessons-Students will get four 20 minute lessons in two weeks. Lessons will be on Monday/Thursday or Tuesday/Friday between the times of 8:40-9:50 and 11:10-3:00. **Cost=\$35.00**

Band and Individual Lessons- Do both Band and Lessons and cut costs!
Cost= \$60.00

Students who wish to do one week may do so!

1 week of band only = \$18.00

1 week of lessons only = \$18.00

1 week of band and lessons only = \$35.00

Continuing Summer Lessons-Lessons after camp is finished.

20 minute lessons - \$10.00 per week

30 minute lessons - \$15.00 per week

Students going into 9th on up grade may come and play in band for free! Those high school students wishing individual lessons will pay the \$35.00 lesson fee. Any high school student is invited to come and play as an expert in the band for free.

There will be a **prize table** in which a name will be drawn daily to determine the winner. Only those who are present will win a prize if their name is drawn! The last day of camp we will have a pizza party at 11:00 a.m. Pizza will be provided for every Band Camp member. Students provide their own beverage! High School students who play in camp will be invited to attend. Band lessons will be adjusted on that day to fit the party in!

Band camp is an excellent way of catching up on lessons, advancing further in the book, and keeping the playing skills going in the summer. There will be no concert at the end of camp. Music played in camp may be music used during the up-coming school year. Sign the attached form and turn in with your check by **June 1, 2009. Checks are to be made out to Mrs. Lynn Mann.** Notes will be mailed/e-mailed home the week of June 8th to notify you of lesson times. *Please note there must be a minimum of 20 students both weeks to make Band Camp work. Checks will be returned if the minimum is not filled. Individual lessons will be scheduled with students.*
